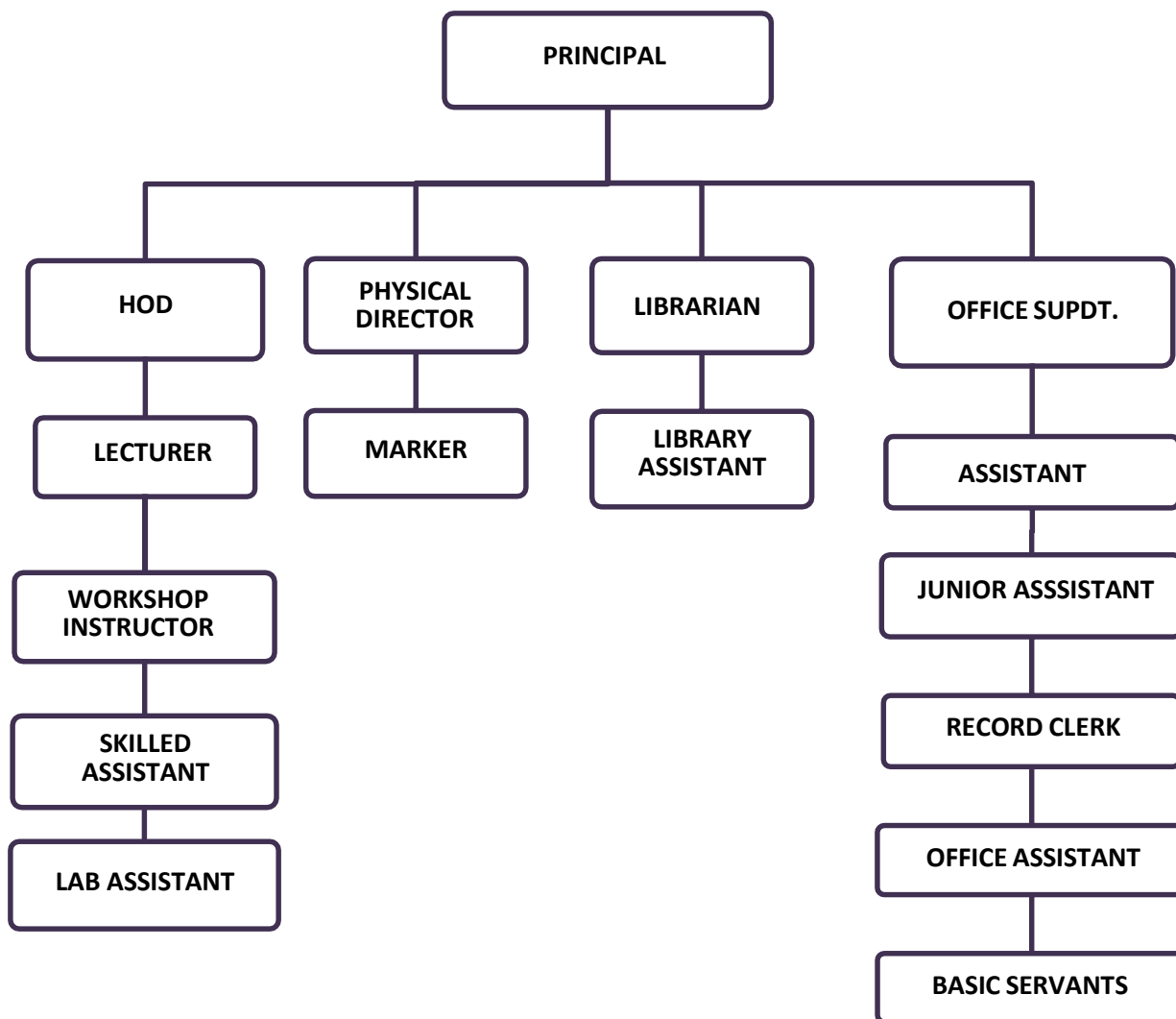

10. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission to Diploma courses instructions to candidates

Application for admission to the courses should be submitted to the Principal of the Polytechnic only by designation and not by name.

Applicants belonging to Tamil Nadu only are eligible to apply. However the following categories of candidates are also eligible to apply.

- a. Children of Central Government employees and children of persons employed in Registered Joint Stock Companies, Private or Public Government Recognised Institutions not domiciled in this state may also apply and compete with other candidates for admission irrespective of their domicile provided the parent or guardian of the candidate is employed for a period of 5 years (Continuously) in this state at the time of Submission of application which should be supported by a certificate from the employer of the parent or guardian. (The certificate should also state that the person is a permanent employees of the firm or institution concerned)
- b. Certificate of permanent residence should be produced by the candidates who have passes their IX, X or their equivalent examinations from high schools situated outside Tamil Nadu for considering them as candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu.
- c. Children of Central Government Employees not domicile of TamilNadu may also apply and compete under open competition for admission, provided their parents or guardians (only if parents are not alive) are serving in TamilNadu continuously for the past five years at the time of submission of application which should be supported by enclosing certificate from the employer of the parent or guardian.
- d. Other State candidates with schooling in TamilNadu from Standard VII onwards need not enclose "Certificate of Permanent Residence". They are eligible for open competition only.

Note: The name of the guardian should be mentioned only if both the parents of the candidates are deceased

QUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION:

1. Minimum Qualification:

A Pass in SSLC with eligible to 1st year Higher Secondary School in Tamilnadu HSC Board Schools.

(or)

Any other qualification recognised as equivalent to a pass in SSLC or X Standard School of TamilNadu High School by the Director of School Education / Secondary Education Board, TamilNadu.

Candidates who are qualified as on 1-7-2021. (i.e. who have passed the qualifying examination during April 2021 or earlier examination) only will become eligible for admission.

Note:

1. Where the subjects "Mathematics" is taught in two individual group, namely as General Mathematics and Composite Mathematics' the candidates who have taken composite mathematics alone are eligible for admission. The candidates who have taken General Mathematics / Elementary Mathematics are not eligible for admission.
2. In respect of candidates who have passed their qualifying examination in other state where the marks in respect of science are awarded subject wise namely Physics, Chemistry, Biology, etc., their eligibility shall be decided taking into account the marks secured in all the individual subjects put together as an integrated one science. The marks secured in the individual subjects alone shall not be considered for the purpose of pass and marks rules i.e. Physics and Chemistry alone or Physics and Biology alone and so on. However, if the candidate is found to have failed in anyone of the individual subjects, in the combined subject 'Science' then such candidates shall not be considered eligible for admission.
3. When grade certificates are produced by the candidates, only the minimum marks for the grades in the subjects will be taken into account.
4. The candidates should satisfy the above qualification and marks rules, in the prescribed qualifying examination, irrespective of the fact of his / her higher qualification.

ALLOCATION OF SEATS:

Selection will be made under six categories.

1. Open Competition
2. Backward class (Others)

3. Backward class (Muslim)
4. Most Backward Class / Denotified Communities
5. Scheduled Caste (Arunthathiyars)
6. Scheduled Tribe

The percentage of seats under the above categories will be as per the orders of Government of TamilNadu.

a) Candidates seeking admission against ST / SC(A) / MBC & DC / BC (Others) / BC (Muslims) should obtain a certificate of social status in the prescribed form (which is a duly numbered and printed one) available with Revenue Authorities concerned.

The candidates should furnish the particulars in variably for item No. 9 (b) of the application form without fail. The candidates who have not furnish the particular for item no. 9(b) at the time of submission of the application they will be treated as belonging to OC.

The candidates should produce at the time of admission, the original community certificate along with a Xerox copy of the community certificate duly attested by officers of Grade A or B.

1. A member of the Scheduled Caste on conversion to Christianity will be considered only under backward class and not under Scheduled Caste.
2. No person who professes a religion different from the Hinduism or Sikh religion shall be deemed to be a member of a Scheduled Caste.
3. A member of Scheduled Tribe will however continue to be treated as such a member, irrespective of whether he is a convert to any religion or he is descended from such a convert.
4. A candidate who claims to belong to scheduled caste by virtue of reconversion should give all and full details regarding date of reconversion and whether the candidate on such reconversion is accepted by members of the particular community of the locality where he/she resides as belonging to the particular community which he claims to belong. Reconversion from christianity to Hinduism will be considered only if notified in the Gazette before 1st July of the year of admission.
5. Candidates are warned that if the community recorded in the certificate produced by them from the competent authority is not included in the list of ST / SC(A) / MBC & DC / BC (Others) / BC (Muslims) given in the annexure to the instructions to the candidates or if the community certificate is not issued / signed by the competent authority, they will not be considered as belonging to ST / SC(A) / MBC & DC / BC (Others)/ BC (Muslims) as the case may be. They will be in that case considered only

under "Others" and privilege that have been given, on the presumption that the candidate belongs to ST / SC(A) / MBC & DC/ BC (Others) / BC (Muslims) as per the details given under that item No. 4(b) of the application form will be withdrawn. The selection made already on the basis of community privilege will be cancelled and they have no compete for a seat under open competition along with others. If they are not qualified to be considered under "others" their application will be treated as rejected.

6. The selection of ST / SC(A) / MBC & DC / BC (Others) / BC (Muslims) candidates under open competition is in addition to the reservation made for them.
7. Permanent Community Certificate of ST should be issued only by the R.D.O. concerned.
8. Permanent Community Certificate issued with State Gopuram Seal, is alone valid for all admission purposes.

MODE OF SELECTION

Selection of candidates for the courses in the Polytechnic will be made purely on the basis of ranking of all qualifying candidates in the order of total marks secured by the candidates in the SSLC examination or in the qualifying examination.

In respect of candidates whose maximum marks in the SSLC or equivalent examination is more than 500 as per scheme, as maximum marks shall be reduced to a basis of 500 and rank arrived at along with other candidates

PUBLICATION OF LIST OF CANDIDATES SELECTED FOR ADMISSION:

The list of candidates provisionally selected for admission shall be published by the principal. The institution shall also display the mark range particulars of selected and admitted candidates in each category, each and every day for the general information of the public. The selected candidates will be intimated of their selection by Registered Post by the principal.

The candidates are in their own interest advised to verify the Notice Board of the Polytechnic / institution where he / she had applied for admission and make himself / herself acquainted with the position. In the event of non-receipt of admission order on the basis of mark range particulars displayed in the Notice Board, the candidate may make representation to the principal inspite of such representation.

If the candidate is not admitted such candidates may send representation to the Additional Director of Technical Education (Polytechnics), Chennai - 25, furnishing all particulars such as marks secured in the basic subjects, Total marks in SSLC or in the qualifying examination, name of the course applied for, the date on which he/she represented to the principal along with a copy of the representation.

The candidates are also advised in their own interest to send their applications duly filled into the principal by registered post with A/D.

THE FOLLOWING ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE SHOULD BE PRODUCED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION TO THE PRINCIPAL.

- a. Conduct Certificate in original from the Head of Educational Institution in which the candidate had last studied.
- b. Transfer Certificate in Original from the Head of the Education Institution in which the candidate had last studied.
- c. SSLC Book or equivalent record.
- d. SSLC Mark Sheet or mark sheet issued by the concerned educational authority for the qualifying examination. (Note: SSLC Mark Sheet issued by the Head Master of the School, will not accepted)
- e. Certificate regarding proficiency in games if any.
- f. Original Community certificate for ST/ SC(A) / MBC & DC / BC others BC (Muslims) from prescribed authority.
